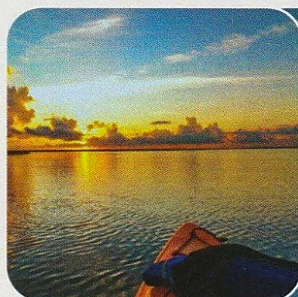
HISTORY

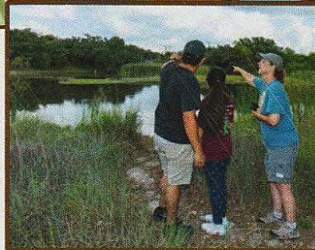
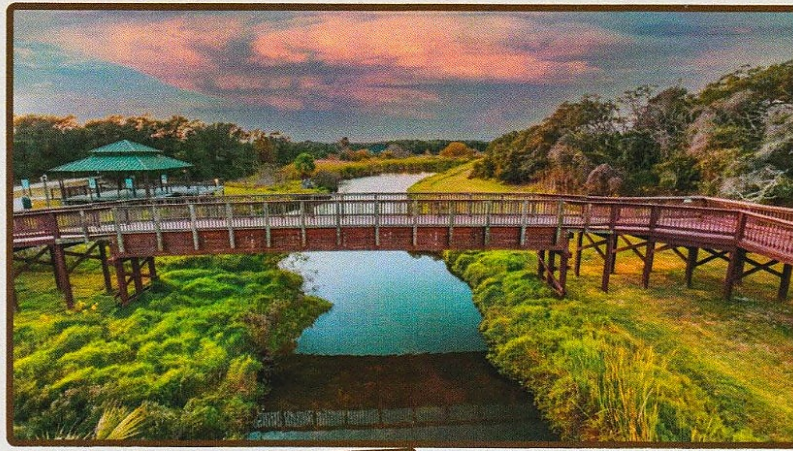
TRAILS

A diverse range of hiking and biking trails awaits your exploration in Aransas County. These paths are designed for adventurers of every skill level. Immerse yourself in the stunning natural beauty and vibrant wildlife that our trails have to offer.



KAYAKING

The Rockport-Fulton Paddling Trail provides diverse paddling options for recreation and fishing, with 26 miles of Bay, Intracoastal Waters, and Shoreline access. Launch sites are available across the trail with intervals going for 1-2 miles, with some stretches up to 9 miles, offering opportunities for fishing and birdwatching along the route.
